

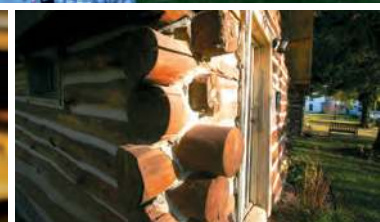


The fully accessible **Steele County History Center** features rotating exhibits, displays, and educational programming relative to Steele County and Minnesota history.
