

Local Rentals: \$13/hour (2 hour minimum)

Start your trip at Minnesota Interstate Park and paddle around the area at an hourly rate. To end your trip, paddle back to where you started.

This option will require you to paddle against the current. \$50 deposit required. Maximum Local Rental charge \$45.50 plus tax.

Group Rates:

With an advanced reservation and a minimum of 6 canoes and / or kayaks, get a discounted group rate.

Weekday rate: \$27.50/canoe or kayak

Weekend rate: Book online for savings

What to bring on your canoe/kayak trip:

- **Garbage bags** The National Park Service has a "Pack it in, Pack it out" policy. Help keep your rivers clean.
- **Sunscreen** (You can get sunburned even on cloudy days)
- **Sunglasses with a strap** (You don't want to lose your glasses in the river)
- **Hat or cap**
- **Water shoes**, old tennis shoes or sandals with straps on the heels (Bare feet or loose sandals are not recommended.)
- **Mosquito/tick repellent**
- **Fishing license**
- **Food, snacks, water** (no glass bottles)
- **Small cooler** (soft sided ones work great in kayaks)
- **Waterproof bag**
- **Beach towel**
- **Seat cushion or extra towel to sit on**
